## The Challenge:

- Originally Planned to purchase all new furniture. Determined the purchase would put DCS over budget
- Moved of occupants within building during renovation phase of each floor
- Coordinated multiple trades

## The Solution:

- We inventoried and planned with existing furniture and managed the reconfiguration of 1st and 2nd floors of furniture, resulting in a savings
