



## AES (Formerly Indianapolis Power & Light) 157,000 Sq. Ft.



### The Challenge:

- Employees occupying half of the building during a 10 floor renovation
- Coordination of 300 employee moves over 3 phases
- 10 floors of furniture moved prior to construction

### The Solution:

- Inventoried 10 floors of furniture and provided asset list to facilities and accounting
- Coordinated and moved 150 employees to an off site temporary space and moved 150 employees to temporary locations within the building. At completion, then moved all to final destination of 5 floors
- Cleared floors of furniture prior to construction which included coordination of 1 semi-trailer of donated items to Goodwill, 2 semi-trailers for reuse to Petersburg plant and 2 straight trucks to Morris Street location. Then properly disposed/recycled items unable to be reused

### The Summary:

- Managed the inventory and disposition of existing furniture for 10 floors
- Coordinated and moved 300 employees with minimal downtime
- Planned reallocation of remaining furniture from upper IPL floors to lower floors for lease
